

ORDINANCE NO. 597

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING OFFENSES PERTAINING TO THE POSSESSION, CONSUMPTION, AND USE OF CEREAL MALT BEVERAGES OR ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE CITY OF LYNDON, KANSAS, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LYNDON, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to have any cereal malt beverages or alcoholic beverages in their possession upon any public street, alley, avenue, sidewalk, park, or any public place not licensed to sell cereal malt beverages or alcoholic beverages, except in the original unopened container, or to drink or consume any cereal malt or alcoholic beverages upon any public street, avenue, alley, sidewalk, park, or in any public place not licensed to sell cereal malt beverages or alcoholic beverages, within the City of Lyndon, Kansas.

SECTION 2. Any person convicted of violating the terms of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00), or by imprisonment of a period not to exceed thirty (30) days, or both such fine and imprisonment.


SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.


