

ORDINANCE NO. 823

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 22 A AND 22 B OF ORDINANCE 781 CONCERNING WATER SERVICE RATES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LYNDON, KANSAS:

That SECTIONS 22 A and 22 B of Lyndon Municipal; Ordinance 781 shall be amended to read as follows:

SECTION 22: RATES. The following monthly rates are hereby established and shall be paid for water furnished and sold by the City of Lyndon, Kansas:

A. Residents whose dwelling is located within the corporate limits of the City of Lyndon, Kansas:

As of October 1, 2017

\$22.51 access fee for single dwelling structures

\$67.53 access fee for multi-dwelling structures. For purposes of this sub-section,

“multi-dwelling structure” means three or more separate residential units (such as four-plex or an apartment complex) that is serviced by one meter.

\$29.99 for up to the first 1000 gallons; includes access fee (\$75.01 for multi-dwelling structures)

\$12.67 per thousand for the next 2000 gallons

\$13.40 per thousand for all usage over 3000 gallons

With this subsection, the term “resident” means each metered location, whether or not more than one family or dwelling is serviced by said meter.

B. Residents whose dwelling is located outside the corporate limits of the City of Lyndon:

As of October 1, 2017

\$28.14 access fee for single dwelling structures

\$84.41 access fee for multi-dwelling structures. For purposes of this sub-section,

“multi-dwelling structure” means three or more separate residential units (such as four-plex or an apartment complex) that is serviced by one meter.

\$37.36 for up to the first 1000 gallons; includes access fee (\$93.64 for multi-dwelling structures)

\$16.72 per thousand for all usage over 1000 gallons


Within this subsection, the term "resident" means each metered location, whether or not more than one family or dwelling is serviced by said meter.

All other provisions of Ordinance No. 781 shall remain in full force and effect.


